Minimum number of years and type of relevant work experience:

At least five years of clinical experience in the treatment of sleep disorders is required for associate professor candidates to be appointed to the CHS track. For assistant professor candidates, 3 years of clinical experience is desired. The CHS track is a non-tenure track emphasizing excellence in clinical care, education and research.

Principal duties:

1. Middleton Veterans Administration Hospital Sleep Program
 - a. Serve as medical director of the VA Sleep Laboratory, with goal of achieving accreditation by the American Academy of Sleep Medicine.
 - b. Develop inpatient and outpatient sleep apnea screening procedures for the VA Hospital.
 - c. Support sleep research at the VA Sleep Laboratory.
2. Engage in teaching activities such as supervising residents and sleep fellows.
3. Wisconsin Sleep, Inc. (Clinical care and research venue)
 - a. 1 to 2 half days of clinic per week and associated interpretation of sleep studies.
 - b. Participate in educational activities assigned by SMPH Sleep Center Director.
 - c. Participate in sleep medicine on-call system.
4. Home department.
 - a. Duties as assigned by chair.

Each clinical faculty member of the School of Medicine and Public Health is based in one of 16 departments and may assume clinical and research roles in a variety of research centers and clinical entities. The incumbent for this position will have such an appointment in a home department but will concentrate their activities in sleep medicine at its clinical and research sites located at the School of

Medicine and Public Health, University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics and the Middleton VA Hospital. Clinical faculty have latitude to define their academic pursuits within these broad parameters.
